

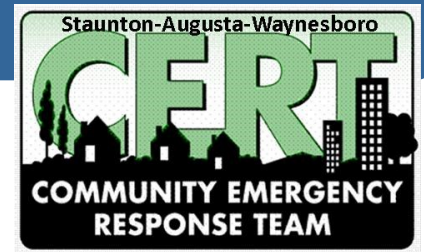
Community Emergency Response Team Training (CERT) Fall 2016
