2024 WIP Scope of Work

"The intent of this project initiative is for each Virginia PDC covering Chesapeake Bay watershed localities to provide technical assistance for Best Management Practice (BMP) implementation to local governments of the Chesapeake Bay Watershed Area."

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Summary

- DEQ-funded to support Chesapeake Bay pollution-reduction goals in the CSPDC region
- 100% funding for stormwater-related BMPs
- Reimbursement grant with no match required
- Up to \$3,500; min \$500
- Open through February 28 to March 29
- Available for localities, non-profits, educational institutions
- Physical construction complete by December 20

About the Program

Three main goals:

- Install structural BMPs that improve water quality and reduce impervious surface run-off
- Provide a simple, streamlined BMP grant application process
- **Support** Watershed Improvement Plan (WIP) goals

Eligible Applicants

Applicants within the five-county CSPDC region that are:

- Municipalities
- Non-profit organizations
- Public education institutions

Priority on non-regulated MS4 areas

- Counties: Augusta, Bath, Rockbridge, Bath, Highland, Rockingham
- Cities: Lexington, Buena Vista
- Towns: Broadway, Craigsville, Dayton, Mount Crawford, Elkton, Glasgow, Goshen, Grottoes, Timberville, Monterey



Address an Identified Need

Projects should address water quality issues like erosion, run-off, poor drainage, and poor vegetation





Eligible Projects

Projects **be fully-constructed** structural stormwater BMP improvements treating water quality and runoff

- Green Infrastructure
- Riparian Buffers
- Constructed Wetlands
- Pervious Surfaces
- Vegetated Swales

- Stormwater Bioretention
- Vegetated Conveyance
- Water Harvesting and Reuse
- Erosion Control Measures
- Tree and Conservation Landscaping

Not eligible: Non-structural BMPs, planning assistance, or educational initiatives not leading to the physical construction of a BMP



Project Evaluation

- Project design
- Project readiness
- Non-MS4 status
- Alignment with Chesapeake Bay pollution reduction goals
- On-going monitoring and maintenance
- Match documentation





2024 Timeline

- Wednesday, February 28, 2024. Application available on the CSPDC WIP website.
- Friday, March 29, 2024. Application in-take period closes at 5:00 p.m.
- Friday, April 12, 2024. Projects are reviewed and selected. Awards announced.
- Friday, April 19, 2024. Project start date pending signed agreement.
- Thursday, August 15, 2024. Mid-point project status update.
- Tuesday, December 20, 2024. Project construction complete.
- Friday, January 10, 2025. Project Completion Report submission deadline.



Summary

- \$3,500 with no match; can apply for more than one BMP
- Application available on February 28 through March 29
- Reach out if you have an idea for pre-screening assistance
- Construction must be complete by December 20
- Reimbursement in January 2025

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
